# A Healthy Child, A Healthy Mind.

- 1. Teach your child about proper handwashing, especially after blowing his/her nose, using the bathroom and before eating.

# **Sports**

#### 2020 School Fees

The school fees for 2020 are as follows:

Standard 1: **P8,850.00** (Eight thousand, eight hundred and fifty Pula) per term, which is **P26,550.00** (twenty-six thousand five hundred and fifty-five Pula) a year.

Standard 2 to 7: P9,400.00 (nine thousand, four hundred pula only) per term, which is P28,200.00 (twenty-eight thousand, two hundred pula) a year.

All other fees and charges remain the same.
